



Book Review this half term

Miss Williams recommends – Where's Lenny by Ken Wilson-Max

Lenny and Daddy enjoy playing hide and seek. Lenny hides and Daddy follows the clues and searches the house for Lenny. Daddy asks Mummy for help and they find Lenny under the blanket, resulting in plenty of tickles, hugs and laughter. The repetition of the phrase "Where's Lenny?" on each page encourages the children to join in with the words. What a wonderful book! I love the illustrations and look forward to the activities I have planned linked to this book.













Mrs Benham-Smith recommends – Astro Girl by Ken Wilson-Max

Astrid has loved the stars and space for as long as she can remember. "I want to be an astronaut!" she says to everyone who will listen. While her mama is away, Astrid and her papa have fun acting out the challenges an astronaut faces on a space mission — like being in zero gravity ("I can do that all day long!" she says), eating food from a kind of tube, and doing science experiments with the help of cookie sheets. When at last it's time to meet Mama at the air base, Astrid wears her favourite space T-shirt to greet her. But where exactly has Mama been? Ken Wilson-Max brings space travel up close for young readers and offers an inspiring

ending.
